## Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

No. 7/2538

On Prescribing the Number of Persons Per Area of Shelters for Workers that are Deemed Excessively Populated

By virtue of the provisions of Section 5 and Section 24 of the Public Health Act, B.E. 2535 (A.D. 1992), the Minister of Public Health by advice of the Public Health Committee hereby issues this Notification as follows:

Clause 1. In this Notification,

"Shelter for workers" means a house, dwelling, shack, or other constructions that are built in compliance with the Building Control Act to be used as a shelter for workers during an ongoing construction project;

"Construction work" means operations that are related to all types of construction, which includes renovation, maintenance, or demolition of such construction;

"Worker" means a person who agrees to carry out construction works for an employer or hirer in exchange of wages, whether such worker receives the wages himself/herself. In this regard, the term shall also include family members of such worker.

Clause 2. A shelter for workers of which each three square metres are populated by more than one resident shall be deemed excessively populated.

Clause 3<sup>1</sup>. This Notification shall come into force after the expiration of ninety days from the date of its promulgation in the Government Gazette.
