

Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

No. 6/2538

On Prescribing the Number of Persons Per Area of Residential Buildings
that are Deemed Excessively Populated

By virtue of the provisions of Section 5 and Section 24 of the Public Health Act, B.E. 2535 (A.D. 1992), the Minister of Public Health by advice of the Public Health Committee hereby issues this Notification as follows:

Clause 1. In this Notification,

“Residential building” means a building that is generally used for residential purpose, both during the day and at night, whether temporary or permanent residency, which also includes dwelling, shack, house, hotel, dormitory, condominium, or any other buildings with similar characteristics that are constructed in compliance with the Building Control Act.

Clause 2. A residential building of which each three square metres are populated by more than one resident shall be deemed excessively populated.

Clause 3. This Notification shall come into force after the expiration of ninety days from the date of its promulgation in the Government Gazette.
