## Notification of the Department of Health

On Criteria, Procedures, and Conditions for Annual Health Checkup and Sewage Management Training Programmes

B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018)

Whereas it is deemed expedient to prescribe criteria, procedures, and conditions for annual health checkup and sewage management training programmes in order to facilitate the person responsible for sewage management according to the Ministerial Regulation on Sewage Management Hygiene, B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018), in arranging annual health checkup and sewage management training programmes for sewage withdrawing and hauling, or disposing staff, so as to equip them with practical and appropriate knowledge on sewage management.

By virtue of the provisions of Clause 11 and Clause 16 of the Ministerial Regulation on Sewage Management Hygiene, B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018), the Director-General of Department of Health hereby issues this Notification as follows:

Clause 1. This Notification shall be referred to as "Notification of the Department of Health on Criteria, Procedures, and Conditions for Annual Health Checkup and Sewage Management Training Programmes, B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018)".

Clause 2. This Notification shall come into force after the expiration of one hundred and eighty days from the date of its promulgation in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3. In this notification,

"Training unit" means

- (1) An agency affiliated with the Department of Health;
- (2) An educational institute, organisation, or other agencies certified by the Department of Health.

Clause 4. The person responsible for sewage management shall arrange annual health checkup for sewage withdrawing and hauling, or disposing staff on an annual basis, which shall include diagnosis of parasites from the gastrointestinal tract.

Clause 5. The person responsible for sewage management shall ensure that the sewage withdrawing and hauling or disposing staff have undertaken relevant sewage management training programmes, as the case may be, provided by a training unit. In this regard, the training

course curriculum, duration specified in Attachment 1, and qualifications of plenary speaker(s) specified in Attachment 2 shall be as prescribed at the end of this Notification.

Staff members responsible for both sewage withdrawal and hauling, and sewage disposal are required to undertake both of the two programmes.

Clause 6. The sewage withdrawing and hauling, or disposing staff who participate in the training programme specified in Clause 5 shall attend not less than 80 percent of the programme in order to be entitled to a training certificate provided by the training unit according to Attachment 3, and are required to undertake training to enhance potential every five years.

Clause 7. An educational institute, organisation, or other agencies to request for approval to be a training unit shall submit a letter to the Department of Health by providing training curriculum, duration, and a list of qualified plenary speakers as prescribed at the end of this Notification.

Obtain at least a bachelor's degree in the field of science or public health programme in science of sanitary science, sanitary, environmental sanitation, science of environmental health, environmental health, health science, or equivalents, with experience in sewage management, or in lecturing about sewage management in a public or private higher education for not less than one year.
